Members of the BOM undertook CPSMA training on the new Child Protection Procedures.

The BOM approved a Compilation of the Financial Statements of the School to year end 31st August 2017 prepared by accountant Seán Walsh.

The BOM is in compliance with GDPR.

The BOM reports school attendance for 2017-2018 at 94% compliance.

The BOM sanctioned the appointment of Mrs. Maria Barrett to the AP1 post which arose in the school.

The BoM were informed of the school's re-engagement with the School Self Evaluation Process.

With BOM approval four exemptions from the study of Irish were granted since June 2017.

The BOM has supported the implementation of the new SEN model in the school and the many initiatives undertaken in this area – Team Teaching, Reading Recovery, Literacy Lift Off, CAPER.

The BOM agreed the purchase of a mobile stage for the school. Playground markings for the junior yard have been sanctioned. The BOM recognises the need to develop the STEM subjects in the school and supports the research and initiatives currently in place in the school.

The BoM is satisfied that the school has met its obligations for Standardised Testing as per Circular 0056/2011 and Circular 0034/2016. Reporting to parents is undertaken as per Circular 0056/2011

The BOM welcomes the appointments of Ms. Ruth Deane to a permanent position in Star of the Sea PS.
